

OUTCOMES OF 2019-2020 ACTIVITIES OF TRANSPARENCY INTERNATIONAL GEORGIA'S COMMITTEES OF CONCERNED CITIZENS IN IMERETI

Improving the system of public transport in Kutaisi, resolving the problems with drinking water supply and outdoor lamp-posts in the villages of Tskaltubo and Tkibuli, rehabilitation and paving of roads in various municipalities – this is but a small list of implemented projects advocated by the members of Transparency International Georgia's (TI Georgia) Committees of Concerned Citizens (CCCs) to the corresponding municipalities. In 2019, our CCC members in Imereti identified 38 problems, and local self-government authorities resolved 15 of them in 2020 using municipal budget resources.

As a result of CC advocacy:

- The improvement of the public transport system started in Kutaisi – the municipality purchased 36 new buses, the transport schedule is being changed, the vehicles are being made accessible to persons with disabilities, procurement of additional buses is being planned;
- Damaged road pavement was fixed on Vazha-Pshavela Street in Kutaisi;
- An acoustic traffic signal was installed on Paliashvili Street in Kutaisi;
- The road leading to buildings No 15 and No 21 on Nikea Street in Kutaisi was fixed;
- The channel drainage by Kupradze Street and Railways Hospital in Kutaisi was cleaned;
- The remuneration of kindergarten teachers in Tkibuli Municipality was increased;
- Outdoor lighting system was fixed in the village of Gelati in Tkibuli Municipality;
- A road section was fixed in the settlement of Mukhuri Village in Tkibuli Municipality, and damaged power poles were replaced in the same settlement;
- A footpath was put in order and outdoor lighting installed near the former resort Savane;
- In Tskaltubo, the pavement of the road linking Public School No 1 and the settlement of Ternali was fixed;
- The road pavement on 9 April Street in Tskaltubo was fixed;
- The installation of a water supply system started and a water reservoir was cleaned in the village of Rioni in Tskaltubo Municipality;
- The improvement of the water supply system began in the village of Zarati in Tskaltubo Municipality, the Municipality purchased the materials required for the rehabilitation of the headworks and completed the installation.

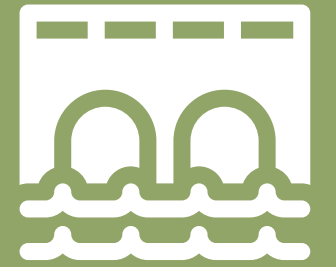
