

INCOMPLETE ASSET DECLARATIONS OF PUBLIC OFFICIALS IN THE KEDA MUNICIPALITY

TI Georgia is presenting information on those officials of the **Keda** Municipality who filled out their asset declarations incompletely – in particular, those who failed to include information about their and/or their family members' property and participation in commercial activity and, also, those who are engaged in activities incompatible with office.

We have studied more than 20 declarations as part of the research, out of which **we revealed 8 cases of incompletely filled out declarations. We also revealed 1 case in which an official was engaged in an activity incompatible with public office, which is a possible violation of law and requires relevant response from the Civil Service Bureau.**

Shukri Turmanidze

Chairperson of the City Council of Keda



In a [declaration](#) filled out on December 29, 2017, Shukri Turmanidze failed to indicate that he owns a 100% stake in [Express-Garanti LLC](#).

Roman Davitadze

Deputy Chairperson of the City Council of Keda



In a [declaration](#) filled out on August 21, 2018, Roman Davitadze failed to indicate that his spouse, Nona Tebidze, is a co-owner of an agricultural [land plot](#) with an area of 1,577 sq. meters, which is located in the village of Pirveli Maisi, Keda Municipality.

Archil Gorgiladze

Chairperson of the Georgian Dream faction of the City Council of Keda



In a [declaration](#) filled out on January 22, 2018, Archil Gorgiladze failed to indicate [premises](#) with an area of 15.39 sq. meters owned by his mother, Mzia Nakashidze, which is located on Abuseridze Street in Keda.

Tariel Manvelidze

Chairperson of the Georgian Dream – Entrepreneurs faction of the City Council of Keda



In a [declaration](#) filled out on March 5, 2018, Tariel Manvelidze failed to indicate that he owns an agricultural [land plot](#) with an area of 2,036 sq. meters in the village of Mosiashvilebi, Keda Municipality.

Guram Beridze

Deputy Mayor of Keda



In a [declaration](#) filled out on September 19, 2018, Guram Beridze failed to indicate that he is the owner of a 100% stake and director of [Beta LLC](#), which is a violation of the [Law on Conflict of Interest and Corruption in Public Service](#). According to the law, a public official may not be the head of a business entity.

TI Georgia calls on the Civil Service Bureau to study the asset declarations of the aforementioned individuals on the basis of the information included in the study and to act in accordance with law.
