

BUSINESS INTERESTS OF TBILISI CITY ASSEMBLY MEMBERS AND VIOLATIONS IN ASSET DECLARATIONS

Transparency International Georgia (TI Georgia) analyzed business interests and activities, and political donations of all 50 members, including 29 public officials, of the Tbilisi City Assembly of the 7th convocation and revealed several violations:

- **8 public officials have incompletely declared their own or family members' business activities:** Zurab Abashidze, Shalva Ogbaidze, Irakli Kheladze, Levan Abashidze, Tornike Bikashvili, Otar Grigolia, Givi Chkhartishvili, and Giorgi Sharashidze.
- **8 public officials have not delegated the right to manage shares in the private companies to other person:** Konstantine Zarnadze, Levan Japaridze, Shalva Ogbaidze, Irakli Kheladze, Tornike Bikashvili, Sopio Japaridze, Giorgi Oniani, and Giorgi Sharashidze.
- **5 public officials still hold a managerial position in a private company,** thus are incompatible with their official position: Konstantine Zarnadze, Shalva Ogbaidze, Tornike Bikashvili, Giorgi Oniani, and Giorgi Sharashidze.
- **4 public officials indicated 0 GEL income received from their or family members' economically active companies in the assets declaration, which could imply an incomplete statement of the income.** These officials are Giorgi Akhvediani, Tinatin Nibloshvili, Levan Arveladze and Giorgi Sharashidze.

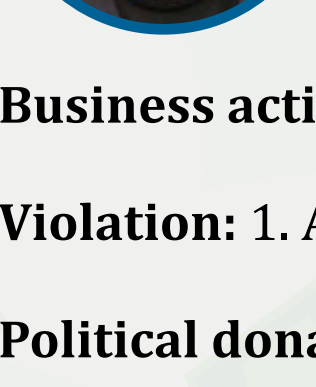

ZURAB ABASHIDZE
Deputy Chairman of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Business activity: His spouse, Teona Benashvili is registered as an individual entrepreneur.*
Violation: In his asset [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, Abashidze did not disclose the business interests of his spouse.

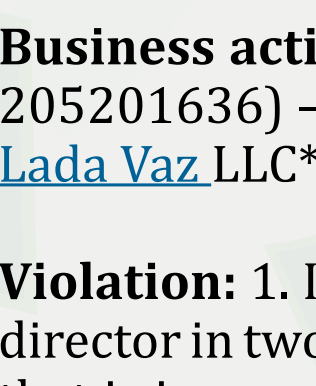
Political donation: In 2021, Zurab Abashidze [donated](#) GEL 1,380 to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, and in 2012-2016 – GEL 43,305 to Free Democrats.



LEVAN JAPARIDZE
Chairman of Audit Commission of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Business activity: Levan Japaridze is a 10% shareholder of [Green Energy](#) LLC.*
Violation: 1. Although required by law, Japaridze did not delegate the right to manage his shares to another person.

Political donation: In 2021, Levan Japaridze donated [GEL 5,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.

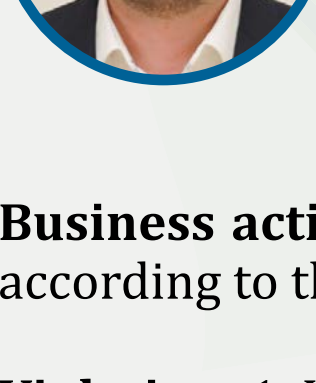


SHALVA OGBAIDZE
Chairman of Transport Commission of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Shalva Ogbaidze owns shares in six companies, serving as a director in two of them: Georgia-Israel Consulting Group* (ID 205201636) – director and 16.7%; [Aautoexpo](#) LLC* – 25%; [M-S-M Group](#) LLC* – director and 33%; [G-T-S](#) LLC* – 50%; [O-&-S](#) LLC* – 100%; [G-T-S Lada Vaz](#) LLC* – 25%.

Violation: 1. In the [declaration](#) submitted in January 2022, Ogbaidze did not disclose that he is a shareholder of six companies and serves as a director in two of them; 2. He did not delegate the right to manage shares to another person; 3. He holds a director's position in private companies that is incompatible with his current position. 4. He did not indicate the GEL 10,000 donation to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia in the declaration.

Political donation: Shalva Ogbaidze donated a total of [GEL 21,300](#) to various political parties in 2012-2021.



IRAKLI KHELADZE
Chairman of Property Management and Finance-Budget Commission of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Business activity: According to his [declaration](#) submitted in February 2022, Irakli Kheladze is not engaged in business activities. However, according to the Public Registry, he is a 100% shareholder of [Khela](#) LLC.*

Violation: 1. Kheladze did not delegate the right to manage shares to another person; 2. He did not indicate about his business activities in the asset declaration; 3. He did not indicate the GEL 10,000 expenditure, donated to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia in the declaration.

Political donations: In 2021, Irakli Kheladze donated [GEL 10,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



OTAR GRIGOLIA
Chairman of Faction “Georgian Dream - Democratic Georgia” of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activities of family members: Grigolia's spouse, Salome Kajaia is a 10% shareholder of [Trajectory](#) LLC.
Violation: In the [declaration](#) submitted in January 2022, Grigolia did not disclose business interests of his spouse.

Political donation: In 2021, Otar Grigolia donated [GEL 5,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.

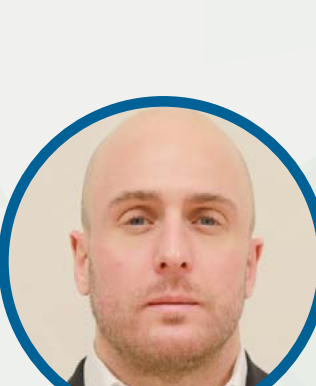


KONSTANTINE ZARNADZE
Deputy Chairman of Faction “Georgian Dream - Democratic Georgia” of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Business activity: Konstantine Zarnadze is a director and a 50% shareholder of [Monument](#) LLC*.

Violation: Although Zarnadze indicated his entrepreneurial activities in his [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, he did not delegate the right to manage shares to another person and did not leave director's position.

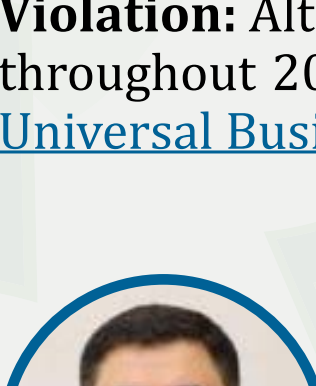
Political donation: In 2021, Konstantine Zarnadze donated [GEL 5,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



LEVAN ABASHIDZE
Deputy Chairman of Faction “Georgian Dream - Democratic Georgia” of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Levan Abashidze owns 50% of the shares of [Sikvaruli Aktsentit](#) LLC*. According to his asset [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, the right to manage this shares was delegated to another person.

Violation: Although required by law, Abashidze did not disclose information in his asset declaration about companies, where he owned shares throughout 2021. In particular, Levan Abashidze was a 33% shareholder of [Advert Room](#) LLC* till March 2, 2022 and a 33% shareholder of [Universal Business Group](#) LLC* till February 24, 2022.

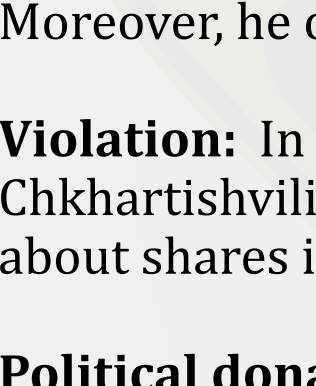


GIVI CHKHARTISHVILI
Deputy Chairman of Faction “Georgian Dream - Democratic Georgia” of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Business activities of family members: Givi Chkhartishvili's father, Malkhaz Chkhartishvili is a director and 50% shareholder of [Mani](#) LLC*. Moreover, he owns 50% of [Magi](#) LLC*. Malkhaz Chkhartishvili is registered as an [individual entrepreneur](#).*

Violation: In the [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, Chkhartishvili did not provide exhaustive information on his father's – Malkhaz Chkhartishvili's business activities. In particular, he only indicated his father's individual entrepreneur's status (0 Lari income), while information about shares in LLCs and the managerial position is missing.

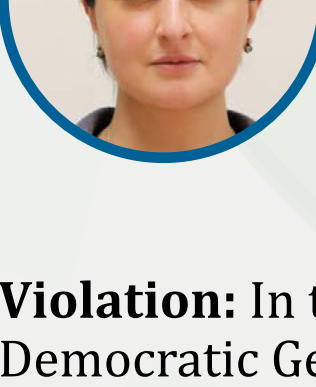
Political donation: In 2021, Givi Chkhartishvili donated [GEL 5,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



NINO RUKHADZE
Deputy Chairman of Faction “Georgian Dream - Democratic Georgia” of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Violation: In the [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, Nino Rukhadze did not indicate GEL 10,000 expenditure, donated to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia and that constitutes a violation of the law.

Political donation: In 2021, Nino Rukhadze donated [GEL 10,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



KAKHABER LABUCHIDZE
Chairman of Education and Culture Commission of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Violation: In the [declaration](#) submitted in January 2022, Kakhaber Labuchidze did not indicate GEL 10,000 expenditure, donated to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia and that constitutes a violation of the law.

Political donation: In 2014-2021, Kakhaber Labuchidze donated a total of [GEL 12,900](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



REVAZ SOKHADZE
Chairman of Urban Planning and Municipal Utilities Commission of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Business Activity: According to the asset [declaration](#) filled out in January 2022, Revaz Sokhadze owns 30% of [Minehouse](#) LLC* and he has delegated the right to manage his shares to another person. According to the asset declaration, he did not receive income from this company in 2021.

Violation: In the [declaration](#) submitted in January 2022, Revaz Sokhadze did not indicate GEL 10,000 expenditure, donated to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia and that constitutes a violation of the law.

Political donation: In 2011-2012, Revaz Sokhadze [donated](#) GEL 32,300 to the New Rights party; in 2017-2021, he donated GEL 10,300 to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.

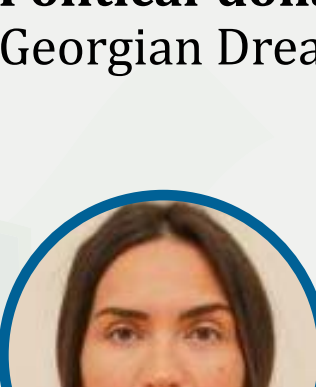


SOPIO JAPARIDZE
Deputy Chairperson of Faction “United National Movement” of Tbilisi City Assembly
United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Sopio Japaridze owns 50% of [Vatika](#) LLC*. Her spouse, Giorgi Choladze is a director of [Vanos Marani](#) LLC* and [Zukas Marani](#) LLC*, a director and 100% shareholder of [Gio](#) LLC*. Giorgi Choladze is registered as an individual entrepreneur*. In addition, Sopio Japaridze's son – Vano Choladze owns 100% of [Yaki](#) LLC.

Violation: 1. Although required by law, Sopio Japaridze did not delegate the right to manage her shares of Vatika LLC to another person; 2. She is as host of the TV-show “Mtavari Diagnozi” at Mtavari Arkhi, that is incompatible with her current position; 3. She did not indicate GEL 60,000 expenditure in the [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, donated to the United National Movement in 2021.

Political donation: Sopio Japaridze donated [GEL 60,000](#) to the United National Movement (2021) and Strategy Agmashenebeli (2020) each. Her business partner, Eter Tskvitinidze donated [GEL 35,000](#) to Strategy Agmashenebeli in 2020.

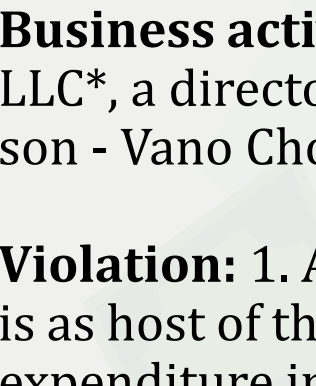


TORNIKE BIKASHVILI
Deputy Chairman of Faction “United National Movement” of Tbilisi City Assembly
United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Tornike Bikashvili is a director and 100% shareholder of [Rashi](#) LLC*.

Violation: 1. Although required by law, Tornike Bikashvili did not delegate the right to manage his shares to another person; 2. He did not resign from a director's position in a private company; 3. In his asset [declaration](#), submitted in March 2022, he did not indicate that he is a director in Rashi LLC.

Political donation: Tornike Bikashvili's spouse, Salome Sigua donated a total of [GEL 20,985](#) to the United National Movement in 2016-2021.



GIORGI ONIANI
Deputy Chairman of Faction “United National Movement” of Tbilisi City Assembly
United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Giorgi Oniani owns 50% of [Amson](#) LLC*, 33.3% of [Charlie](#) LLC*; he is a director and a 33.33% shareholder of [Law Firm - S.O.V. Sajaia,Oniani,Velijanashvili](#) LLC*.

Violation: 1. Although required by law, Giorgi Oniani did not delegate the right to manage his shares to another person; 2. He did not resign from a director's position in private companies; 3. According to his [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, registration of the above mentioned LLCs and an entrepreneur's status were abolished when declaration was submitted. According to the National Agency of Public Registry, the status of an individual entrepreneur was abolished [after](#) he submitted the asset declaration.



GIORGI SHARASHIDZE
Deputy Chairman of Faction “Tbilisi for Georgia” of Tbilisi City Assembly
For Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Giorgi Sharashidze is an [individual entrepreneur](#) and linked with the following companies:
[Entrepreneur Georgia](#) LLC – director and 100% shareholder;
[Intelligent Hospital](#) LLC* – director and 100% shareholder;
[Geomultimedia](#) LLC* – director and 70% shareholder; the company, in turn, owns 100% of [Focus](#) LLC*;
[Total Media](#) LLC – director and 70% shareholder;
[Newspaper Georgia Today](#) LLC – 40% shareholder;
[WHERE](#) LLC* – director and 70% shareholder;
[Global Media Trade](#) LLC* – 70% shareholder;
[Innovation Group Georgia](#) LLC* – 17% shareholder;

[Georgia Today Group](#) LLC.– director and 70% shareholder;
[Media Management Service](#) LLC* –director and 70% shareholder;

1) Power Info LLC* (I/c: 205280159) – director.

Giorgi Sharashidze's spouse, Maia Tsereteli is a director and a 40% shareholder of [Exclusive Print](#) LLC*, a director and a 50% shareholder of [Intelligent Media](#) LLC, a director of [Focus](#) LLC* and [an individual entrepreneur](#).

Public procurement: 96 simplified procurement contracts (GEL 522,060) were concluded with 8 companies directly or indirectly linked with Giorgi Sharashidze in 2011-2022. These companies won 39 tenders (GEL 946,221).

7 simplified procurement contracts worth a total of GEL 47,400 were concluded with [Entrepreneur Georgia](#) LLC in 2018-2022.

Contracts on 3 simplified procurements (GEL 22,436) and one tender (GEL 15,000) were concluded with [Total Media](#) LLC.

[Newspaper Georgia Today](#) LLC- the company won 16 tenders (GEL 500,029) and obtained 23 simplified procurement contracts (GEL 114,758).

[Georgia Today Group](#) LLC- the company won 3 tenders (GEL 127,626) and obtained 30 simplified procurement contracts (GEL 196,158).

[Media Management Service](#) LLC- the company won 1 tender (GEL 13,000) and obtained 7 simplified procurement contracts (GEL 25,975).

[Focus](#) LLC – the company won 3 tenders (GEL 11,200) of which one was not fulfilled, and obtained 12 simplified procurement contracts (GEL 24,700).

[Exclusive Print](#) LLC – the company won 12 tenders (GEL 246,366) and obtained 9 simplified procurement contracts (GEL 81,028).

[Intelligent Media](#) LLC – the company won 3 tenders (GEL 33,000) and obtained 5 simplified procurement contracts (GEL 9,605).

Violation: 1. Although required by law, Giorgi Sharashidze did not delegate the right to manage his shares to another person; 2. He did not resign from a director's position in private companies; 3. In his [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, Giorgi Sharashidze did not provide exhaustive information about his and his spouse's entrepreneurial activities; 4. According to the declaration, Sharashidze did not receive income from some of its economically active companies in 2021.

Political donation: Giorgi Sharashidze's business partner, Nikoloz Nakopia donated a total of [GEL 93,555](#) to the United National Movement in 2020-2021.

PUBLIC OFFICIALS WITH BUSINESS INTERESTS WHO SUBMITTED THEIR ASSET DECLARATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW

No violations have been identified regarding the business activities of these public officials of the Tbilisi City Assembly. Nevertheless, we believe that it may be useful for citizens to know about the links between the companies and their representatives to the Tbilisi City Assembly.

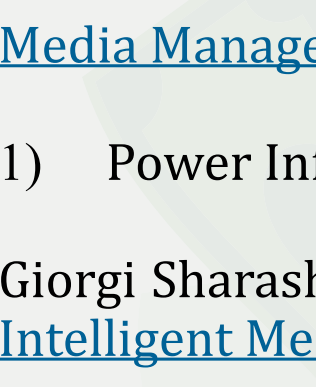


GIORGI AKHVEDIANI
First Deputy Chairman of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Giorgi Akhvediani's spouse, Ketevan Akhvediani owned 34% of [B.M.G. Consulting](#) LLC (from 21.05.2020 -Parker Russell Georgia LLC), which she sold at USD 51,500 on May 28, 2021. According to the asset [declaration](#), Ketevan Akhvediani received no income from this company in 2020. B.M.G. Consulting LLC owns 50% of [B.M.G Brokers](#) LLC*; however, according to the Public Registry, the process of the company's liquidation is not completed.

Alleged case of nepotism: According to the asset [declaration](#) filled out in October 2021, Giorgi Akhvediani's spouse, Ketevan Akhvediani serves as the head of the Passenger Service Office of Tbilisi Transport Company LLC at the Tbilisi Municipality. Ketevan Akhvediani has been holding this position since March 2015 after Giorgi Akhvediani was elected a member and the deputy chairman of the Tbilisi City Assembly of the 5th Convocation. This case was highlighted in TI Georgia's [report](#) on nepotism released in 2019.

Political donation: In 2021 and 2014, Giorgi Akhvediani donated a total of [GEL 7,662](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



TINATIN NIBLOSHVILI
Deputy Chairperson of Tbilisi City Assembly
Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: According to the asset [declaration](#) submitted in January 2022, Tinatin Nibloshvili's spouse, Valerian Grdzlishvili is a director and 20% shareholder of [Europe](#) LLC. According to the asset declaration, he received no income from this company in 2021 and “neither is he engaged in its management.”

Alleged case of nepotism: Tinatin Nibloshvili's spouse, Valerian Grdzlishvili serves as the head of Monitoring Department at Kindergarten Management Agency of Tbilisi Municipality. Valerian Grdzlishvili has been holding this position since June 2018 after Tinatin Nabloshvili was elected a member and chair of one of the commissions of the Tbilisi City Assembly of the 6th Convocation. Earlier in 2013-2016, Valerian Grdzlishvili served as the deputy head of the Administration of Tbilisi Police Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs. He submitted his last asset declaration while serving on this position in [January 2016](#) (in the capacity of a former official).

Political donation: In 2021, Tinatin Nibloshvili donated [GEL 5,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



NINO VARDOSANIDZE

Chairperson of Denominations and Symbols Commission of Tbilisi City Assembly

Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Nino Vardosanidze's father, Aleksandre Vardosanidze is a director of [Agromavali](#);* a director and 50% shareholder of [ALDA](#)* LLC; also, director of [Bampi](#) LLC*.



LEVAN ARVELADZE

Chairman of Economic Development, Investment Policy and International Relations Commission of Tbilisi City Assembly

Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Levan Arveladze owns 50% of [Punctum](#) LLC, and he has delegated the right to manage these shares to another person. Despite the company's [active](#) status, according to the [declaration](#) submitted in February 2022, Arveladze received no income from this company in 2021.

Political donation: Levan Arveladze donated [GEL 10,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia on October 12, 2021. His business partner, Nikoloz Kvirikadze donated [GEL 300](#) to Elene Khoshtaria – Droa in 2021.



AVTANDIL TSINTSADZE

Deputy Chairman of Faction “Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia” of Tbilisi City Assembly

Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Majoritarian

Political donation: In 2021, Avtandil Tsintsadze donated [GEL 5,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.

According to the asset [declaration](#) submitted in March 2022, Avtandil Tsintsadze's spouse, Lana Morgoshia has been serving as the deputy head of the Analytical Department of the Ministry of Justice since October 2021. In the asset [declaration](#) submitted in December 2021, Lana Morgoshia did not indicate either Avtandil Tsintsadze or the assets owned by him and his bank accounts that constitutes a violation of the law.



SABA BUADZE

Chairman of Faction “Lelo – Partnership for Tbilisi” of Tbilisi City Assembly

Lelo for Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: According to the [declaration](#) submitted in February 2022, Saba Buadze's spouse, Nino Guntsadze is registered as [an individual entrepreneur](#).

Political donation: In 2019-2020, Saba Buadze donated a total of [GEL 60,000](#) to Lelo for Georgia. His spouse, Nino Guntsadze donated [GEL 10,000](#) to the same party in 2020.

MEMBERS OF TBILISI CITY ASSEMBLY WHO ARE NOT REQUIRED TO SUBMIT ASSET DECLARATIONS

21 members of the Tbilisi City Assembly do not have the status of public officials. Due to this, they are not required to submit asset declarations, while their business activities are not restricted. Accordingly, [the information provided below does not constitute any violation](#). Nevertheless, we believe that the public should be aware of the business activities carried out by their representatives at the Tbilisi City Assembly.



GURAM OKROPIRIDZE

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Guram Okropiridze is a director and 100% shareholder of [IFC Georgia](#) LLC* (the process of liquidation is underway).

Public procurement: In 2018-2019, IFC Georgia LLC concluded 3 simplified procurement contracts worth a total of GEL 8,614.



ALEKSANDRE KHUJADZE

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Aleksandre Khujadze is a founder and 51% shareholder of [AX](#) LLC*; also the executive director and a 33% shareholder of [Nabo](#) LLC*.

Public Procurement: In 2011-2012, Nabo LLC won 7 tenders worth a total of GEL 477,796.44 and concluded 2 simplified procurement contracts worth GEL 51,205.

Political donation: In 2021, Aleksandre Khujadze donated [GEL 5,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia.



AKAKI ALADASHVILI

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Akaki Aladashvili owns shares in the following five companies: [Transporter](#) LLC – 10%; [GSA Consulting Group](#) LLC*– 66%; [Multi Construction Group](#) LLC*– 30%; [Eco Firm](#) LLC *– 23%; [Crossroad Trans](#) LLC *– 17.5%.

Public procurement: In 2016-2021, Transporter LLC won 62 tenders worth a total of GEL 2,832,990 and concluded 72 simplified procurement contracts worth a total of GEL 1,308,192.

Political donation: Akaki Aladashvili donated [GEL 40,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia on October 13, 2021. His business partner, Sergo Shugarov donated [GEL 60,000](#) to Salome Zourabichvili in 2018.



LEVAN DAVITASHVILI

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia, Party-list representative

Business activity: Levan Davitashvili owns 100% of [Dream House](#) LLC.

Political donation: Levan Davitashvili donated [GEL 50,000](#) to Georgian Dream – Democratic Georgia in 2017.



ZVIAD KUPRAVA

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Zviad Kuprava is a director and 33.3% shareholder of Akti Vita LLC* (ID 200219101); he also owns 5% of [Gineka](#) LLC*.



IRAKLI EDZGVERADZE

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Irakli Edzgveradze is registered as [an individual entrepreneur](#)*.



MIKHEIL KAKAURIDZE

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Mikheil Kakauridze is a director and a 50% shareholder of [Lux 21](#) LLC*; he also owns 100% of Baali LLC* (I/c 200254839).

Political donation: In 2020, Mikheil Kakauridze donated [GEL 8,000](#) to the United National Movement.



MAMUKA GUGESHASHVILI

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Mamuka Gugeshashvili owns the shares in the following companies: [Dzeglevi](#) LLC* - a director and 70%; Tsipa LLC* (I/c: 200162670) – 50%; [Football Club “Tbilisi” of Tbilisi](#)* LLC – 100% and [Electronics ge](#) LLC *– 50%.



BARBARA JIMELI SULASHVILI

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

United National Movement, Party-list representative

Business activity: Barbara Jimeli Sulashvili owns the shares in the following companies: [American-Georgian Education Center](#) LLC – 10%, [Georgian Discovery Tours](#) LLC – 50%, [Bio Farm Pona](#) LLC – director and 20%. Bio Farm Pona LLC, in turn, owns 30% of [Naturpuri](#) LLC*.

Public procurement: In 2013, a simplified procurement contract worth GEL 18,123 was concluded with the company Georgian Discovery Tours LLC associated with Barbara Jimeli Sulashvili.

Political donation: Barbara Jimeli Sulashvili donated [GEL 1,000](#) to the United National Movement in 2021. Her business partner, Giorgi Sulashvili donated a total [of GEL 28,000](#) to the United National Movement in 2016-2021.



ALEKSANDRE RATISHVILI

Member of Tbilisi City Assembly

Anna Dolidze – For People, Party-list representative
